- Must not have worked at CERN before with any other status (Technical Student, Trainee, User or other status) for more than 3 months and have not have previously been a Summer Student at CERN.
- · Possess a good knowledge of English; knowledge of French would be an advantage.

Benefits

CERN would very much like to benefit from your expertise, commitment and passion. In return, CERN will provide you with:

- A contract of association of 9 weeks to work on an advanced IT project.
- An extensive IT lecture programme. Students will also be able to attend the CERN generic summer student lecture programme if they wish.
- A 90 CHF per calendar day (net of tax) subsistence allowance to cover the cost of accommodation and meals in the Geneva area for a single person for the whole contract duration.
- Applicants will be given travel allowance on a lump sum basis paid at the end of their stay to help with the cost of travel between Geneva and applicant's residence at the time of application.
- Coverage by CERN's comprehensive Health Insurance scheme (contribution is already deducted from the daily allowance).
