A lump-sum travel allowance paid at the end of your stay to assist you in covering the expense of travel between Geneva and your residence at the time of the selection committee.

Health insurance (contribution is already deducted from the daily allowance).

Assistance in locating lodging on or near the CERN site.

Eligibility Criteria:

This Summer Student Program accepts applications from candidates of all countries.

Open to Bachelor or Master's students (not PhDs) with a strong computer profile who have completed at least three years of full-time university education by summer 2022.

During your time at CERN, you must be registered as a student.

You are also eligible to apply if you plan to graduate during the European summer of 2022 (as of May).

You shouldn't have worked at CERN for more than 3 months in any other capacity (Technical Student, Trainee, User, or other status).

English language proficiency is required; knowledge of French would be advantageous.
